Lancaster Footlights first performed at the Ashton Hall in November 1921. The following year, they hired the Grand theatre and continued using it up to 1935 when it became a cinema. From then on they used Priory Hall, the Jubilee Hall and Ashton Hall for performances. In 1951, Footlights purchased the Grand from ABC cinemas. It was in a pretty bad state and Footlights have progressively restored it to its present amazing condition. Over the years, other local amateur societies began to use the theatre and in 1995 the first professional acts were included to help run and maintain the Grade II listed building. This gradually developed over the years and there is now half and half split of community and professional lets.

Footlights is a thriving amateur drama group which takes a professional approach to its work. We first started performing in the 1920's, and purchased the Grand Theatre in 1951, saving it from demolition. We currently produce four plays per year at the Grand Theatre, including a traditional Christmas pantomime which is specifically aimed at family enjoyment and a Family production in the summer.

With an historic Grade II listed building to maintain, a thriving and busy theatre to run, a full season of plays to cast, sets to build, backstage and front of house staff to find and train, we are always on the look out for new members to step forward and help us. Hearing Loop

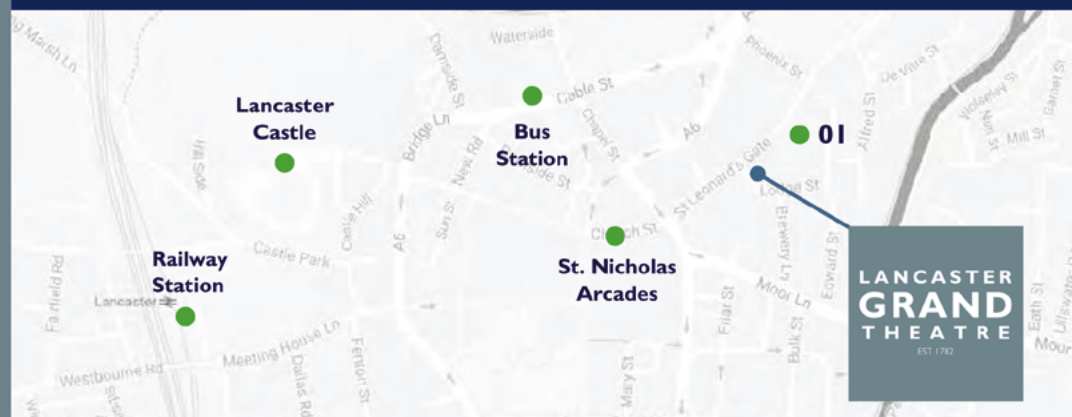
